



The Severn Way Walk

Organised by the Rotary Club of Stourport on Severn

Stage 9 - Arley to Holt - Saturday 15th May



Introduction - The Severn is the longest river in the British Isles and passes through some beautiful countryside and lovely villages, town and cities. The walk is approximately 230 miles from Llandiloes in Wales to the centre of Bristol. The objective is to walk the Severn Way in stages as a relay over a 16 day period to raise money for charity. You can walk one or more stages, some of the stages will be broken down into sub stages so you can walk as little or as far as you would like.

Starting Places for the Walk – There will be 3 starting places and all will be ending in Holt - Top Barns. Opening Times for the starts and distances :-

Application - The registration fee of £10 enables you to walk as many stages as you wish, for this you will receive a tee shirt, details of each stage, information on preparation for the walk, sponsorship forms and regular updates. You can use the Registration forms overleaf or the form that will be available on the website from February.

For organising the Walk, the Rotary Club of Stourport on Severn and its partners will retain 20% of the sponsorship money for the Rotary charities. Administrative costs will be kept to a minimum with Rotary members and friends providing their time for NO cost.

The Relay Walk - A Rotary banner will be carried the whole length of the walk, to which will be attached the bannerettes of the Rotary Clubs that we will meet along the length of the Severn, in Bristol and other participating Rotarians.
